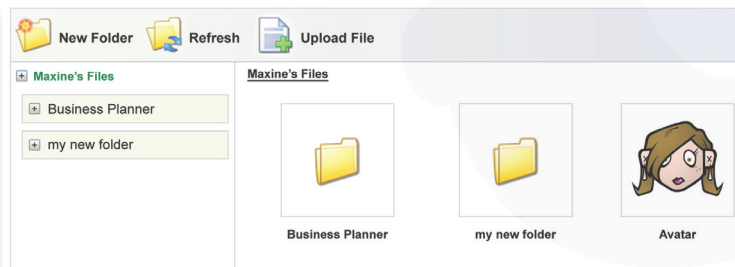
Enterprise to go! is a course which helps students work out what they are good at and to get them to imagine if they were starting a business, what would it be? Students take any of the 24 modules within the course, in any order, to gain the knowledge and skills needed to help them realise their potential as budding entrepreneurs.

Once students have registered and logged into the course they will also have access to The Entrepreneur's Podcast.



Enterprise Portal contains hundreds of links to a range of websites about all things enterprising. Each site has been rated and reviewed to help students quickly find information by browsing or searching on keywords.

Within **destination enterprise**, there are interactive community-building activities and personal development tools in which users enter their own content. These include forums, blogs and the development and updating of personal enterprise portfolios of achievement.



My Enterprise Portfolio

Everything the students create during their enterprise activities, they save within their personal online enterprise portfolio.



My Career Builder

The career builder is a wizard-style tool which guides students through the process of recording their learning history, skills and interests, aspirations, work experience, and at the end generates a CV which can be downloaded and manipulated by a student or saved to their portfolio.
